

Frontline Youth Worker Support for Young Women & Gender-Diverse Youth at Risk of Violence

Project Highlights

- **Art Against Knives (AAK)** created safe, creative spaces for young women and gender-diverse individuals at risk of violence
- Provided creative skills training, mentoring, and wellbeing support.
- Through **NW9 Nails** and **Dollis Dolls**, reached 45 young people with over 40 weekly creative sessions
- Activities like nail art, podcasting, jewellery making, and creative wellbeing workshops

Key Achievements

- **100% of participants** received tailored mentoring and creative support
- **95%** felt their emotional wellbeing and self-confidence improved
- **85%** were inspired to explore new career paths and skills
- **14** young people gained paid work within AAK's programmes
- Delivered an empowering end-of-project showcase
